Overview: Get to know the world a bit better from the comfort of your classroom.

Time: 5-10 minutes

Equipment required: World map on a pin board, 2 colours of pins.

Benefits:

- Integrates seamlessly into geography.
- Can be adapted to any level of difficulty.
- Helps teach about the world.

The game:

- 1. Put up a large world map on a pinboard.
- 2. Name a place in the world see across for examples of places.
- 3. Invite the children to come up and put a pin where they think that place is found.
- 4. Pin the actual location in a different colour so they can see how close they were.

Places:

- 1. Countries: "Where is Canada? Where is Australia?"
- 2. Animals: "Where do polar bears live? Where would you find elephants?"
- 3. Landmarks: "Where can you see the pyramids? Where is the Eiffel Tower?
- 4. Currency: "Where can you spend dollars? Where can you spend Yen?"
