
SCRAP PAPER HEART BOUQUET



Gather up your excess wrapping paper and create a beautiful heart bouquet for Mum.

EACH CHILD WILL NEED:

- ✦ Coloured paper or scrap wrapping paper
- ✦ Coloured card or white card
- ✦ Glue stick
- ✦ Scissors
- ✦ Ribbon
- ✦ Pen



ASSEMBLY:

- ✦ Gather supplies as indicated above.
- ✦ Carefully cut out some heart shapes in varying sizes. An easy hack is to fold the paper in half and cut one side of the heart, easily duplicating the other side of the heart.
- ✦ Arrange hearts in a bouquet-style arrangement.
- ✦ Stick in place. Stick only one half of the heart.
- ✦ Draw some string.
- ✦ Add a bow.
- ✦ Write your personalised message inside!



FLOWER DOOR MINI CARD




Make a cute floral peek-a-boo card.

EACH CHILD WILL NEED:

- ✦ Coloured paper or scrap wrapping paper
- ✦ Coloured card or white card
- ✦ Glue stick
- ✦ Scissors
- ✦ Pen

ASSEMBLY:

- ✦ Gather supplies as indicated above.
- ✦ Fold base card as per the diagram below. Cut in half (to make two cards).
- ✦ Cut a flower shape out of a 10cm x 10cm square.
- ✦ Cut the flower in half and stick a half on each of the front folds of the card.
- ✦ Cut around the stuck on flower shapes (so the front folds are now 'half flower' shaped).
